

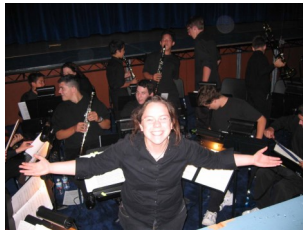

Jazz Band, Orchestra, Beginning Strings, & Percussion Ensemble

Percussion Ensemble includes beginning to advanced level students. Any band student may join and play percussion instruments in this class. Students already renting to own will not have to buy additional equipment.



This class meets on **Wednesdays** 4:00-5:15 and is taught by a our percussion instructor. **Andy Greenburg** is a former Middle/High School Chaminade student earning his degree at Pasadena College and having played in drumline.

The fee is \$130 for the year or \$90 per semester. It runs an average of \$10 per session.

Most private lessons run an average of \$60 per hour.

Jazz Band meets on **Tuesdays**. Instrumental experience is strongly recommended. Often students take this class in addition to their band class. Instrumentation consists of saxophones, trumpets, trombones, piano, bass, guitar, vibraphone and drum set. Guitar students should be taking lessons in addition to this class so they can test what they are learning in a group situation. Band students have priority over non-band students for piano, drums, bass & guitar.
